SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Conference participants have the opportunity to publish the results of their research free of charge in the scientific journal *"Bulletin of Agricultural Science of the Black Sea Region,"* which is included in Category B of Ukraine's scientific professional publications, as well as in the conference proceedings with an assigned **ISBN**. Each submitted abstract included in the conference proceedings will be assigned a **DOI**. PhD students may submit abstracts either individually (with their academic advisor indicated) or in co-authorship with their academic advisor. Abstracts from students pursuing a first (bachelor's) or second (master's) level of higher education must be submitted only in co-authorship with their academic advisor. Each author may submit no more than two abstracts.

The organizers will provide conference participants with an event program, collections of articles and abstracts, souvenirs, and other materials.

Self-citations (references to the author's own works) are allowed but must not exceed 10% of the total number of sources.
