REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF MATERIALS

The conference participants have the opportunity to publish the results of their research **free of charge** in the scientific journal "Black Sea Agricultural Science Bulletin", which is included in Category B of scientific professional publications of Ukraine and in the conference abstracts collection with an assigned ISBN. Each submitted abstract included in the conference abstracts will be assigned a DOI. The electronic version of the collection of abstracts will be posted in the Repository of Mykolaiv National Agrarian University: <https://dspace.mnau.edu.ua>.

Theses of postgraduate students (applicants for higher education of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy) can be submitted both individually (with the indication of the supervisor) and in co-authorship with the supervisor. Theses of applicants for the first (bachelor's) and second (master's) levels of higher education are submitted only in co-authorship with a supervisor. One author can submit no more than two abstracts.

The organizers provide the conference participants with a program of events, collections of articles and abstracts, souvenirs, etc.

- send the abstracts of the conference, prepared in accordance with the requirements, to forum@mnau.edu.ua by **April 30, 2025**.

The content of the article and abstracts should correspond to the conference theme. The language of the article and abstracts is Ukrainian, English, and other languages. The Editorial Board reserves the right to make editorial corrections. Abstracts are published in the author's version. The volume of abstracts is **up to three full pages**. Formatting of abstracts: A4 paper size, margins - 2.0×2.0×2.0×2.0 cm, Times New Roman Cyr, 14 pt, spacing - 1.0, indentation - 1.25 cm. References to the authors' own works and/or abstracts (self-citation) are allowed, but not more than 10% of the total number of sources.
